TECHNICAL DATA SHEET

Product Name: DIAZEPAM CHINFIELD

FORMULA:

Diazepam	500 mg
Formulation agents q.s. to	100 ml

TARGET SPECIES:

Equines. Canines. Felines. Camels.

INDICATIONS:

Tranquilizer, muscle relaxant, anticonvulsant, anxiolytic, and orexigenic.

PRESENTATION:

Printed cardboard box containing a Type II amber vial with label and leaflet.

Content: 10 ml and 25 ml.

APPEARANCE:

Clear, transparent solution, very slightly yellowish.

DOSAGE AND ADMINISTRATION:

Injectable: slow intravenous, intramuscular. Rectal in canines and felines as an anticonvulsant.

CANINES AND FELINES:

Tranquilizer, muscle relaxant, anxiolytic: 0.1 ml – 0.5 ml per 5 kg b.w.

Orexigenic (cats only): 0.05 ml – 0.1 ml per 5 kg b.w.

Anticonvulsant: 0.5 ml – 1 ml per 5 kg b.w.

Anesthetic induction and maintenance: 0.1 ml – 0.2 ml per 5 kg b.w. (*always with propofol or ketamine).

EQUINES:

Tranquilizer, muscle relaxant, anxiolytic: 1 ml – 4 ml per 100 kg b.w.

Anticonvulsant: 1 ml – 2 ml per 100 kg b.w.

Anesthetic induction and maintenance: 1 ml – 2 ml per 100 kg b.w.

CAMELS:

Tranquilizer, muscle relaxant, anxiolytic: 2 ml – 10 ml per 100 kg b.w.

Anesthetic induction and maintenance: 4 ml per 100 kg b.w.



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CONTRAINDICATIONS:

Hypersensitivity to any of the components of the product.

It is recommended not to use diazepam to control seizures in cats exposed to chlorpyrifos as it may enhance organophosphate intoxication.

Diazepam has been implicated as a cause of congenital abnormalities in humans when administered during the first trimester of pregnancy. The veterinary relevance is uncertain, but its use during the first third of gestation should only occur when benefits clearly outweigh the risks.

Benzodiazepines and their metabolites are distributed in milk and may cause CNS effects in nursing neonates.

SIDE EFFECTS:

In horses, diazepam may cause muscle fasciculations, weakness, and ataxia at sedative doses.

Cats may show behavioral changes (irritability, depression, aberrant behavior).

Dogs may exhibit a paradoxical response (CNS excitation) after administration.

WARNINGS:

Keep out of reach of children and pets. National Poison Control Center: 0800-333-0160 Buenos Aires, Argentina.

Must be administered by a veterinarian.
